A Haughley in Bloom Working Party met July 16 and their report was presented to the Parish Council July 21

The 43 Tubs in the village are in varying stages of decline and urgent work is required to save as many as possible. Left untreated the tubs will continue to decay until they simply fall apart.

So, ALL the tubs will be lifted, washed and inspected in the Autumn at a date yet to be decided. Work to restore the tubs will

begin when the tubs have properly dried out.

This is a very big undertaking and more volunteers would be VERY welcome! Parishioners should be aware that the sorry state of some of the tubs means that there will be fewer tubs when restoration work has been completed. Thus, there will be a new siting plan for the salvaged tubs will be needed.

The plan will take into consideration:

- a. the number of salvaged tubs
- b. the willingness of parishioners to help care for them
- c. key points where roads enter the village

The Working Party includes people from Haughley New Street, Haughley Green, Haughley Village and the Parish Council.

The intention is to formally include both Haughley New Street and Haughley Green in future planting schemes.
