I am delighted to report that our application for an award to support Haughley in Bloom was successful.

The award and on-going Parish Council support means that we can all look forward to a successful Haughley in Bloom re-launch!

We have already purchased

- > and planted some spring bulbs,
- > 10 railway sleepers to make new planters
- > some compost
- > some wood stain/preservative to begin treating the salvaged ½ barrel tubs as soon as the weather permits

We now plan to begin working on the following

- > Complete our new planter siting and planting plans
- > Treat the salvaged tubs as soon as is practicable
- Purchase some new planters for Haughley Old Street
- > Construct and site the new planters made from the purchased railway sleepers
- > Re-site our salvaged and treated planters, which we were lifted at the end of 2016
- Plant up all the planters in the Spring
- > Review the outcomes of our efforts and develop a long-term plan
